Do I need a special installation system?

No you don't, Cedral Terrace has a unique clip design to ensure a quick and simple design and is compatible with other clip systems

How much does a single plank weigh?

A single 175mm Cedral Terrace plank weighs 17kg

Does It splinter?

Due to the manufacturing process Cedral Terrace will not splinter. It's great for kids, pets and your bare feet!

Can I remove and replace individual planks?

Yes. There are 2 methods available using the Cedral Terrace accessories please refer to the Cedral Terrace Installation Guidance notes

Is Cedral slippery when wet?

Cedral Terrace has a low slip potential when wet.

Can I put my BBQ on Cedral decking?

Yes. Even if it hot charcoal falls onto Cedral it won't burn or support combustion.

Will the colour fade?

Cedral Terrace is a through coloured material with mineral/inorganic pigments that are UV stable so will retain its colour for much longer than other decking materials.

Does anyone else make decking like this?

Cedral is patented, so no-one else can make fibre cement decking in the same way we can.

Will Cedral change shape and twist?

No it won't. Intense heat, cold and exposure to the elements have no effect on the shape of Cedral.

How scratch/weather-resistant is it?

All materials can be scratched, however due to the through colour nature of the material scratches are not readily apparent and will not cause the material to rot or affect its performance or durability. Cedral Terrace is resistant to heat, rain and snow.

How should it be cleaned?

We have a full set of cleaning recommendations if cleaning is necessary including removal of common stains. Please refer to the Cedral Terrace Guidance notes.

How much maintenance is needed?

Cedral Terrace requires virtually no maintenance. We recommend a brush down to remove dirt and cleaning if stains/moss growth occur on the material. Please refer to the Cedral Terrace Guidance notes.

How durable is it?

Cedral is made of fibre cement which is longer lasting than wood, but feels much softer under foot.
